Admission for seniors is \$6, \$5 for City of Shawnee residents. A tour guide will give us a private tour of the grounds, lasting approximately 1-1/2 hours. We will have box lunches (Approx. 11:30 AM) on the grounds provided by McClain’s market and eat picnic style at tables adjacent to the Visitors Center. Restrooms are available at the Visitors Center.

There is a choice of (3) Box lunches; 1) Chicken Salad sandwich with house chips, 2) Smoked Turkey sandwich with house chips, or 3) Vegetarian friendly wrap with house chips.
