Leldon Hudson's BBQ Sauce for Ribs

Ingredients

1/2 cup onions Chopped
1/8 cup salad oil
4 oz Tomato Sauce
1/4 cup water
1/8 cup brown sugar
1/8 cup lemon juice
1 1/2 tbsp Worcestershire sauce
1 tbsp prepared mustard
1 tsp salt
Dash of pepper

Step 1

In a saucepan, cook onions in hot oil until tender.

Step 2

Add remaining ingredients, and simmer uncovered for 15 mins

Thomas Hudson's Layered Lemon Dessert

Ingredients:

1 stick of butter softened
1 cup all-purpose flour
1 tsp salt
1 cup chopped pecans, toasted
1 cup powdered sugar
1 8 ounce package cream cheese softened
1 lg container Cool Whip
2 3 ounce packages instant lemon pudding
3 cups milk
Toasted coconut or toasted pecans for topping

Step 1

Mix first 3 ingredients together and press into a 9 x 13 inch Pyrex dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Cool completely

Step 2

Mix together 1 cup powdered sugar, softened cream cheese and 1/2 of Cool Whip and spread over cooled crust.

Step 3

Mix together pudding and milk and pour over cream cheese layer. Top with remaining Cool Whip and then nuts or toasted coconut.

Step 4

Refrigerate for at least 6 hours or overnight.

Variations.

Chocolate: substitute 2 packages instant chocolate pudding for lemon pudding. Dust with cocoa powder, grated chocolate or top with nuts

Butter Brickle: Substitute 1 cup crushed Heath Bar for nuts in crust and butter pecan pudding for lemon. Top with Cool Whip and additional crushed
